In the aftermath of Cyclone Fani

Rebuild Odisha









Introduction

The Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm FANI made its landfall near Puri on 3rd May, 2019 with wind speed reaching up to 200 KM/hr. Though the respective government machineries are fully mobilized to reduce the human risks, there has been extensive damage to infrastructure and property especially in Khurda and Puri District. Aaina with its field presence in the districts of Khurda and Puri and having a primary mission of responding to disaster situation keeping the human rights of people in general and persons with disability, women and children in specific is has been providing relief to the affected community in terms of food, medicine, drinking water, clothing, health support, baby and child care need, sanitation, menstrual hygiene management, first aid kits and of course temporary shelter. Our primary purpose was to provide immediate relief to the affective communities and to continue our effort henceforth in restoration and rebuild process.

Scope of our Activities.

The scope of our activities has been to:

- To assess the damage and vulnerability of communities and people in terms of physical,
 Psychological and socio-economical dimensions.
- 2. To provide immediate relief to communities who were affected by the hazard and are still trying to cope up.
- 3. To plan intervention strategy in rebuild and restoration of normalcy and in dealing with PTSD, Livelihood, education and "WASH".

Target Beneficiaries

Our target beneficiaries are all the affected households and individuals in Khurdha and Puri district. However, special attention has been given to Person with Disability, Adolescent girls, Elders, Women and Children due to their vulnerable social circumstances. Our intervention strategy was also designed to recognize and cater to the needs of families headed by:-

- Single Parent/Deserted women
- Widows
- Person with Disability
- Elderly

Activities so far

We have undertaken number of intervention program in the affected communities that includes:-

1. Health Camps



We have conducted 12 health camps with 6 in Bhubaneswar and 6 in Bramhagiri and Nimapada block of Puri district with support from Americare Foundation and Dr. Gayatri Mohanty. The purpose of the health camps were to provide immediate medical relief to the community who are facing medical issues in light of the calamity that resulted in destruction of shelters, community ponds and sources of drinking water. The health camps focused on providing first aid to people and to adolescent girls and women who were the worst sufferer after contamination of drinking water, lack of food and hygienic living conditions.

2. Relief Kit distribution.



In Aftermath of Fani, people lost their shelters along with their access to basic needs such as water, and their ability to buy basic household utilities to safeguard their health wellbeing and hygiene. Adolescent girls and women faced serious complications, especially regarding their menstrual hygiene. Lack of water and shelter facilities, financial crisis and contamination of food and drinking water and what not, has given them little time to cope up with their menstrual and overall health. Aaina took up the responsibility to address these issues by providing immediate access to essential utilities that includes:

- a) Drinking water supply to immediate access to clean drinking water to slums in Bhubaneswar.
- b) Dignity Kit for women and adolescent girls that include sanitary pad, inners, tooth brush, tooth paste, and tongue cleaner, detergent soap and bath soap.
- c) Hygiene Kit for households that includes Bucket, mug, hand wash, bleaching powder, soap, sanitary napkins
- d) Household Kit for household to take care of their basic necessities and utilities, This includes Water storage container, bucket, mug, Mosquito net, candle, match box, saree, blanket, bed sheet, dress,.
- e) Baby Kits for infants in household who face neglect in regards to their health and hygiene. The baby kit includes Diapers, Baby rub, and detergent and Tooth brush.
- f) Tarpaulin was distributed to affected household who lost their thatched roofs or Asbestos. To provide them with an immediate shelter.
- g) Sarees were provided to affected household for women who lost their clothes during the cyclonic storm.
- h) Food materials including, chudda, Jagerry, dal, biscuit and cooking oil to affected household who were vulnerable in the society, e.g ST/SCs, women headed household, households with Person with Disability, deserted women and Elderly headed households.

Future course of Action

Aaina is determined to continue the effort to rebuild these communities and help them return to their livelihood and normal way of life, along with engaging them to rebuild their surroundings and community assets like water bodies and village surroundings. Our future plans includes:-

- 1. Assist and advocate for preexisting state government schemes and programs to reach the last mile beneficiary.
- 2. Support and training program for farmers and fishermen to help them resume their livelihood.
- 3. Engage community in rebuild programs like, rejuvenation of local water bodies, forestation and cleaning up of village surroundings etc.
- 4. Support and psycho-social intervention with school children to help them catch up with their education and deal with their Post calamity Trauma.
- 5. Support and engage with vulnerable section of society like dalits, tribals, elderly, women and adolescent girls with various activities and support services to help them recover from the trauma and losses because of their vulnerable social situation and limited social capital.
